

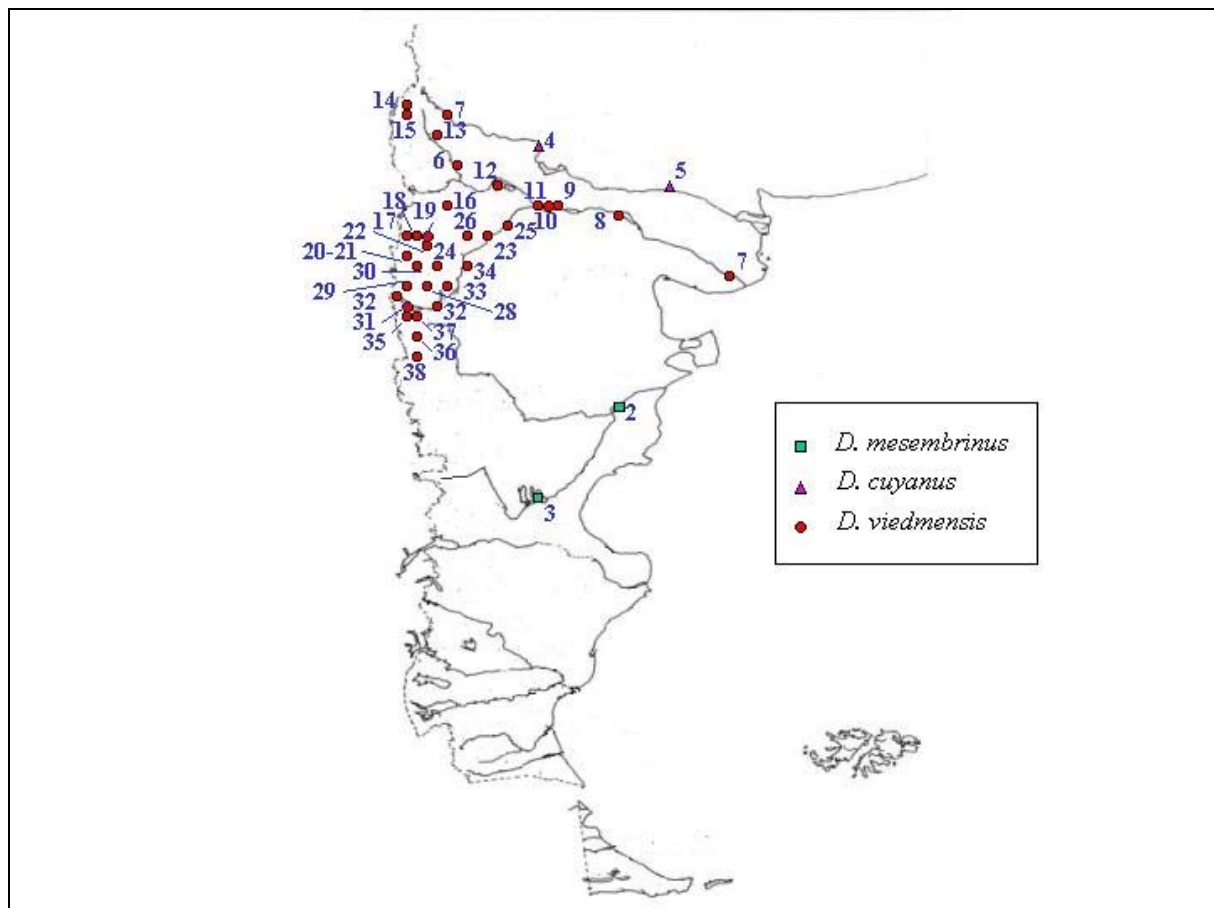

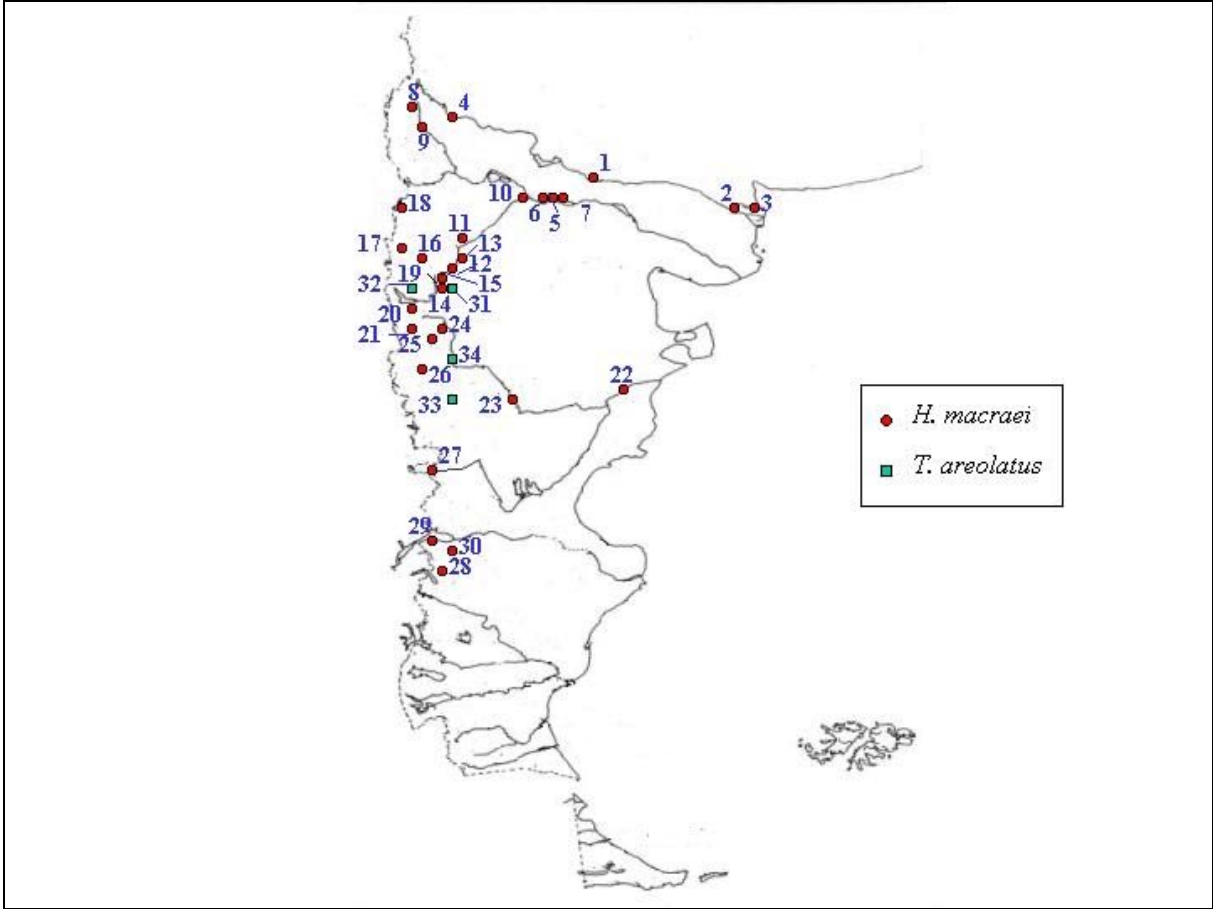

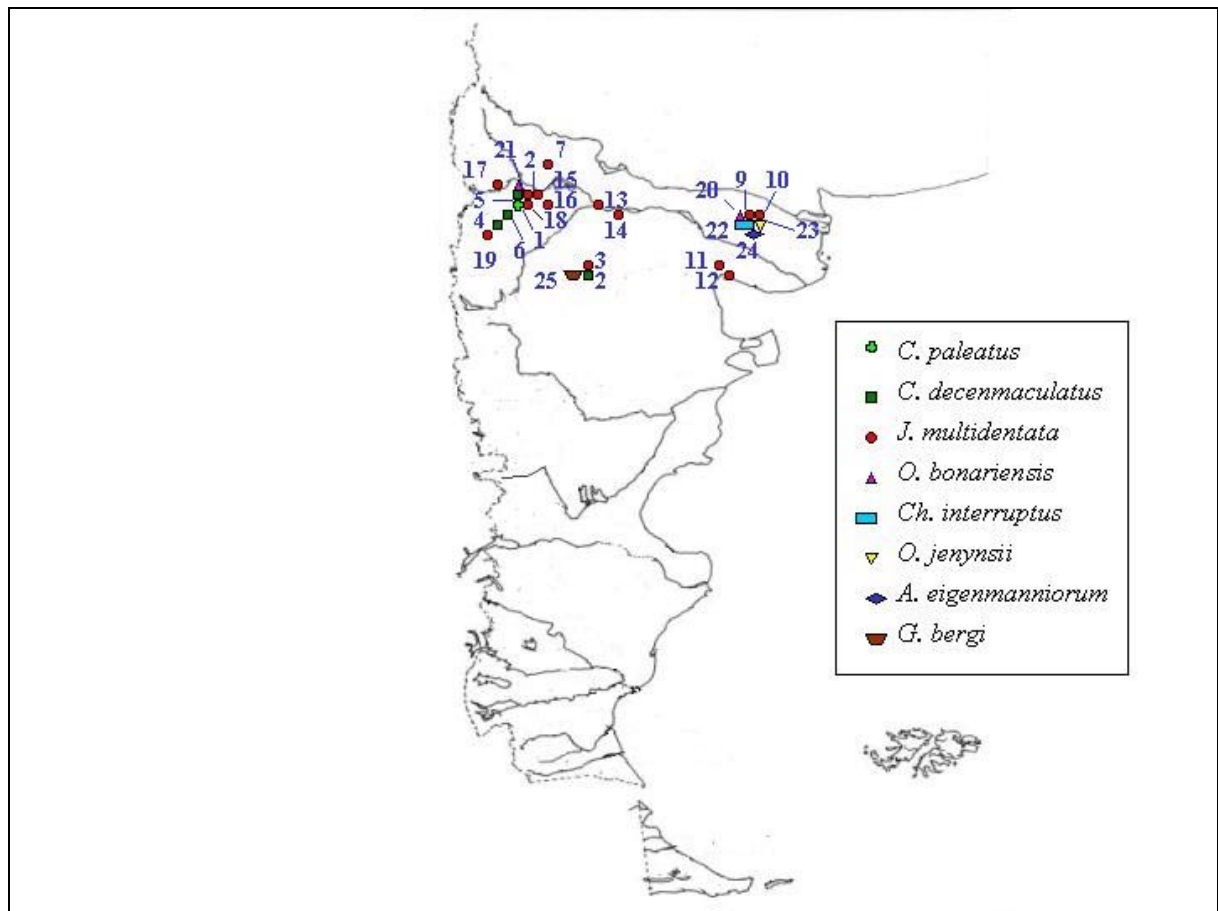

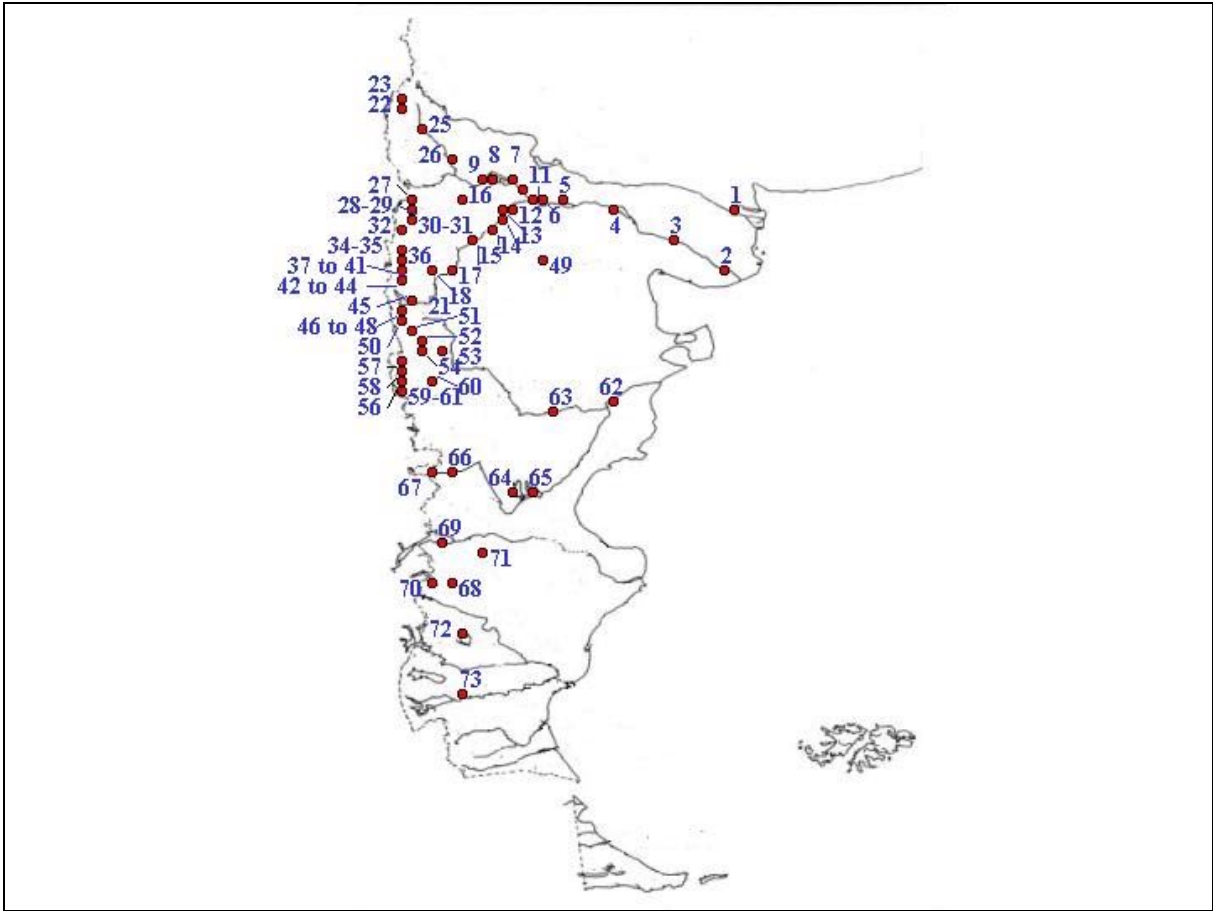

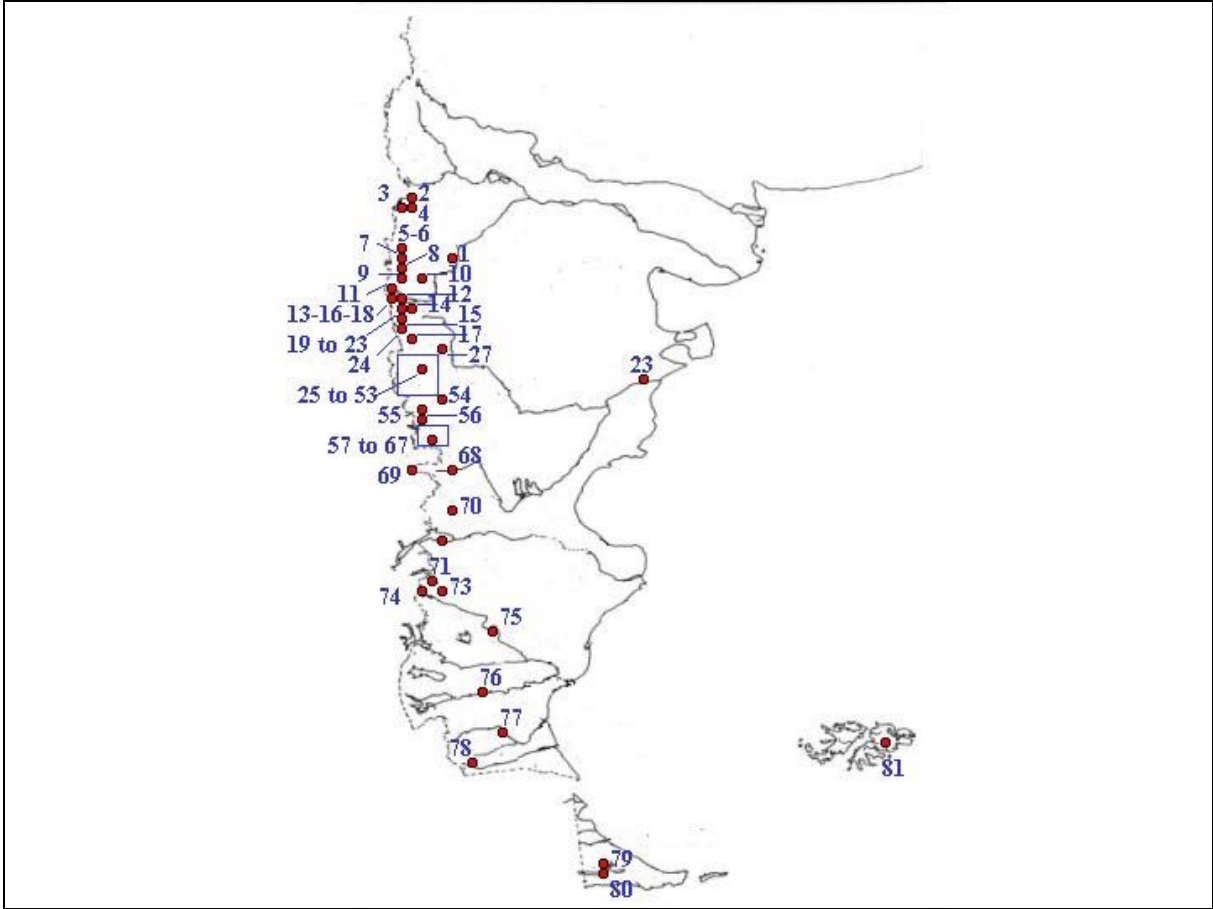

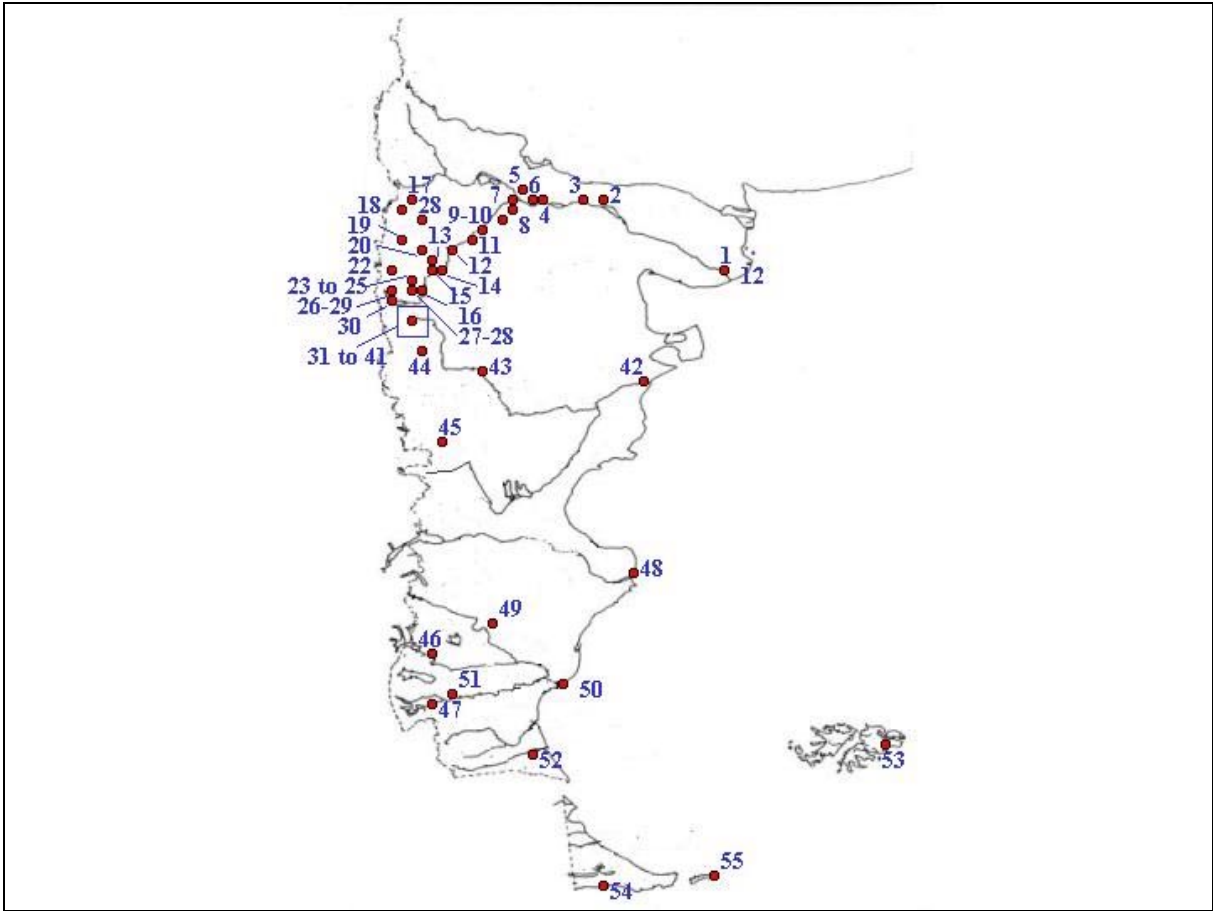

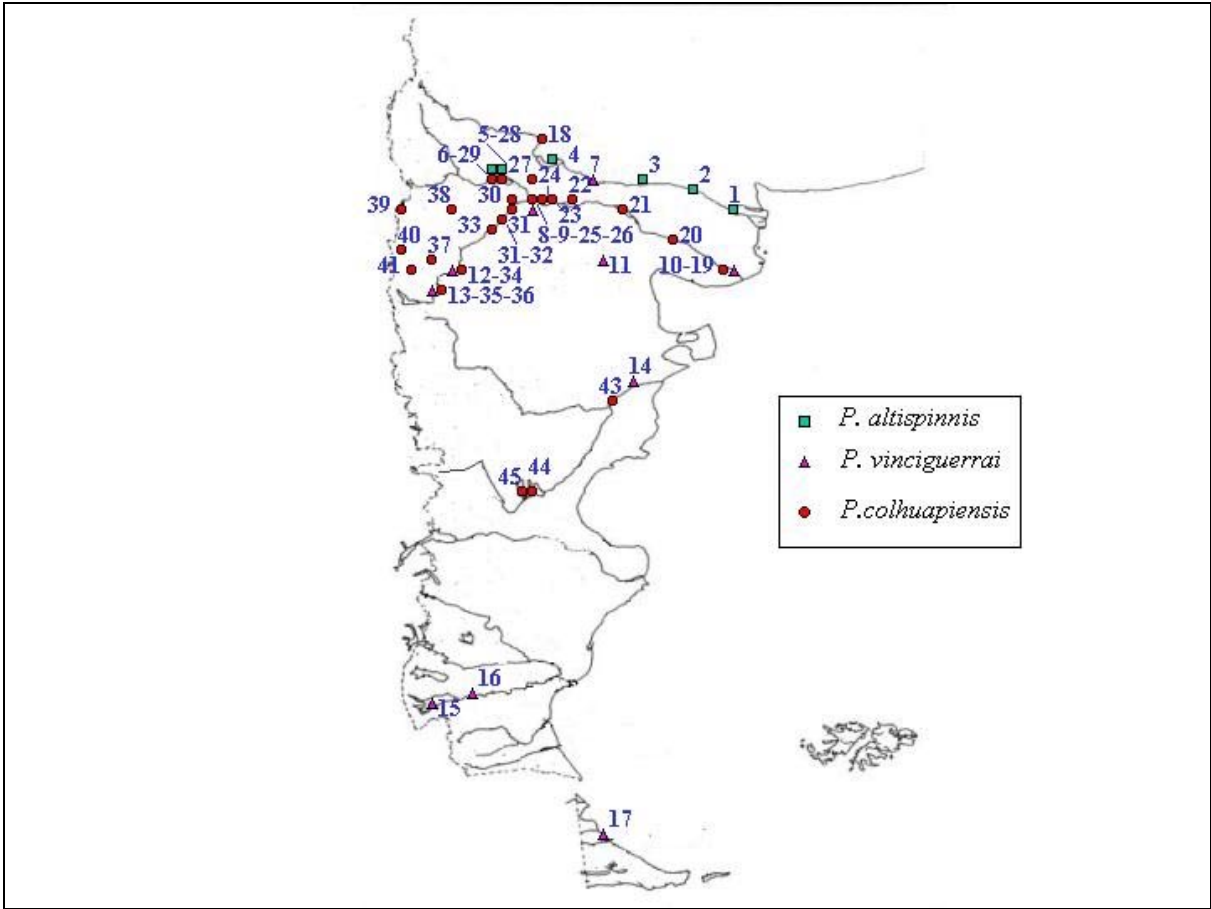

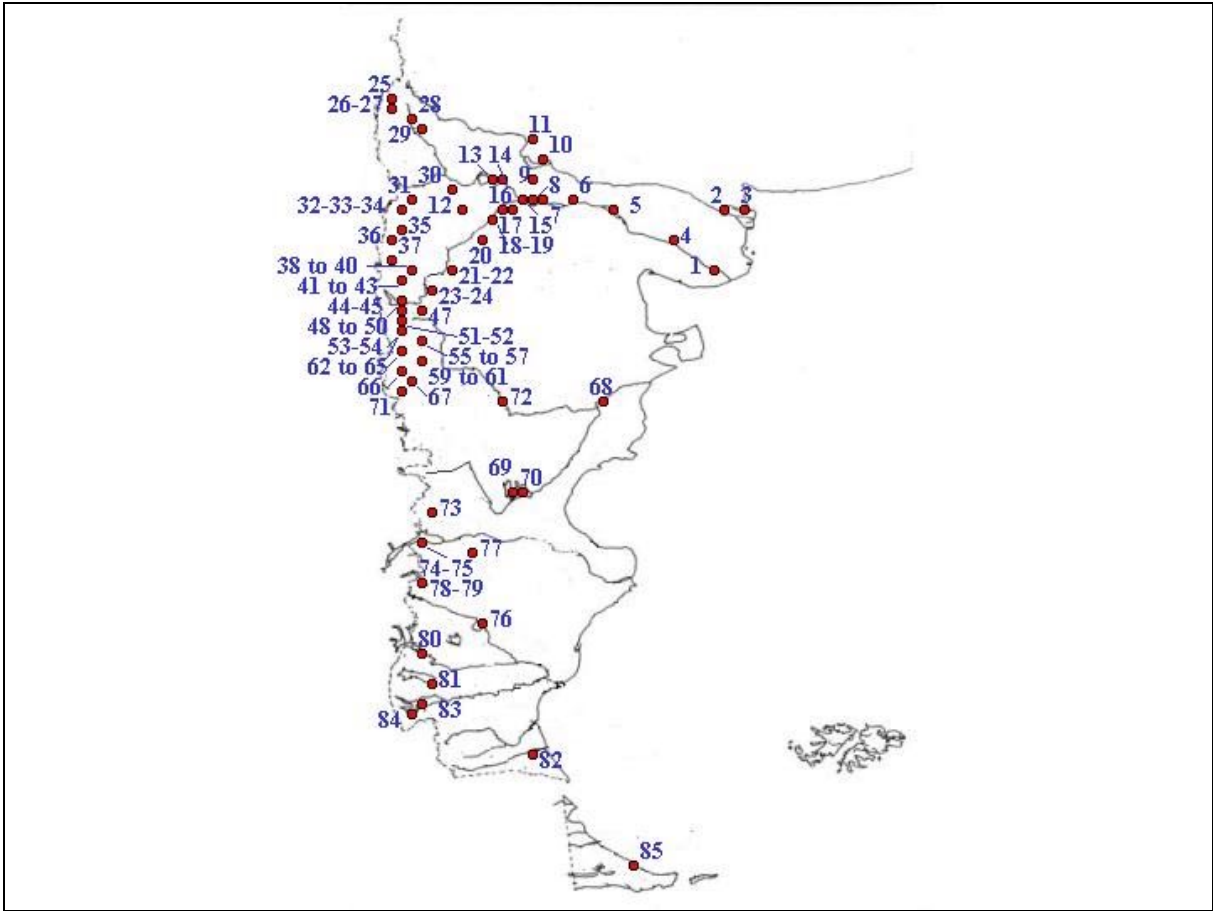
**Fig. E.** Geographical distribution of *Galaxias platei*. Numbers correspond to sampling localities as presented in Table O of this Electronic Supplement.



**Fig. F.** Geographical distribution of *Galaxias maculatus*. Numbers correspond to sampling localities as presented in Table P of this Electronic Supplement.

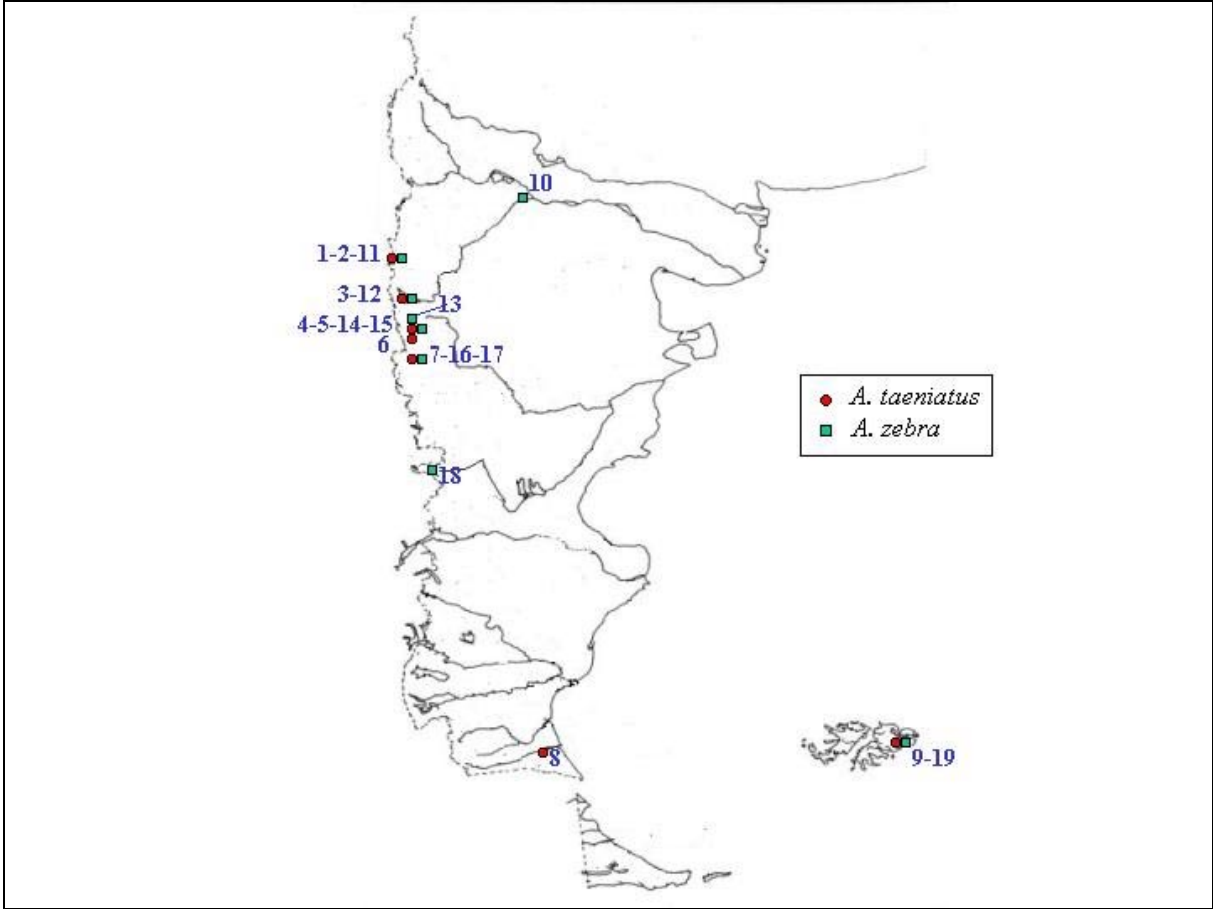
